- The organization of the school in Miniemeninstituut is on very high level, compared to the other schools in Belgian educational system.

- The headmaster is very cooperative with the teachers and supports their ideas and themselves very much. On every level.
- The headmaster consults the teachers a lot.
- The teachers are very autonomous and disciplined by themselves, in the way like: Job has to be done!
- The composition of the time tables is much better in Miniemeninstituut.
- The Miniemeninstituut is trying to be a modern school, giving a new way of education and new way of teaching.
- I like new teaching methods.
- It is very good from didactical point of view and for the quality of teaching that the classes are not so big, with less students, approximately 17.
- I noticed, that it is also very good that the school starts at 8.35. I would like to have such organization in my school.
- It is also very good that on Wednesdays lessons and teaching finish earlier.

My training mobility consisted of:

- Didactical approach in courses of: English, German, geography, tourism: 40 hours.
- Representation of Slovenia by geographical and historical point of view: 12 hours.

- Attended the presentation "Teaching less, learning more" by Hugo Winnelinckx, specialist of the Finnish school system.
- Visit to The House of Dutch (Huis van het Nederlands).
